# THE FOUNDATION UNDERTAKES A MAJOR SHIFT

The Lise Watier Foundation is very proud to present its first-ever annual report. The decision to produce this publication coincides with a major shift within our organization—and perhaps the timing isn't coincidental after all.

In the nine years that have passed since the Foundation was established, we have supported thousands of women and girls in need by distributing the funds received from our valued donors to local organizations offering programs that are aligned with our mission. This experience has allowed us to gain a better understanding of women's expectations and the assistance that is available to them. Inspired by the entrepreneurial spirit of our founder, Lise Watier, we decided to start offering services directly to women in precarious situations. Our goal is to offer them the means to take control of their lives and become financially autonomous.

With this in mind, we developed the Let's Start Up Program for women who want to make lasting improvements to their living conditions. We currently operate out of three service points and plan to expand to five more by 2022 to help an ever greater number of women regain their dignity and self-confidence, and reach their full potential.

In 2017/2018, we invested tremendous energy and love into developing this innovative program and organizing various fundraising activities that, as you will discover in the following pages, were very successful. This report also includes information about our organization, our accomplishments in the past year and our financial situation.

Our success in helping women over the years would not have been possible without the dedication and contributions of our donors, volunteers, partners and other benefactors.

# Our mission takes us higher

Created in 2009, and propelled by the continual drive of entrepreneur Lise Watier, the Lise Watier Foundation offers concrete means to women in need to take control of their lives. By providing the appropriate tools and support, we offer women here the possibility of developing their talents and aspirations, for a better future for themselves and their children. We offer training, individual and personalized professional counselling, financial support and microloans with the aim of helping these women acquire the pride and confidence of being financially autonomous.

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## 2017/2018 A SIGNIFICANT YEAR FOR THE FOUNDATION

Over the past year, the Lise Watier Foundation was at the centre of numerous exciting projects and many new developments. Here is a brief overview of our achievements during this period.

#### 1. LAUNCHING THE LET'S START UP PROGRAM

Let's Start Up has been offered to women in need since October 2017 in three Quebec regions:

- Montreal YWCA
- Laurentians Fonds d'emprunt des Laurentides
- Quebec City Centre étape

The Program provides professional training, personalized coaching and financial support to women who voice a desire to take control of their lives by:

- Starting a business
- Re-entering the workplace
- Persuing post-secondary education

The goal is to help participants achieve their sustainable social and financial autonomy. It is an extension of the emergency support and social reinsertion services already available in the community.

# A MOTIVATING FIRST INTERREGIONAL MEETING FOR ADVISORS

Let's Start Up program advisors met in Montreal for their first regional meeting on February 13 and 14. They participated in training activities, discussed the Program and talked about their experiences at the different service points. The meeting was an opportunity to share lessons learned and determine areas for improvement. Everyone left feeling motivated and proud to be a part of the initiative. The advisors are already looking forward to their next meeting!



#### THE LET'S START UP PROGRAM GETS OFF TO A STRONG START

- 67 women in three regions across Quebec have already completed their training program.
- 49 chose the entrepreneurship path and have either started or finished writing their business plan.
- 18 have taken steps to return to the workplace or pursue their studies.
- 11 young single mothers received financial support to further their post-secondary education.
- 125 hours of training were provided.
- 275 hours of personalized counselling were provided

#### 2. SUPPORTING POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION

In addition to all the new developments introduced in 2017/2018, we continued to support our education program, which provides financial assistance to young women who wish to pursue post-secondary studies. Dans la rue, Sherbrooke University and the Let's Start Up Program points of service submit applications on behalf of deserving young women with incredible life stories. After analyzing the profiles of each applicant, our board of directors makes the final selection and determines how much will be granted to each recipient.

#### 3. DEVELOPING OUR NEW BRAND IMAGE

To help the Lise Watier Foundation stand out in the philantropic environment, we called on the services of key partners who generously agreed to support our organization over the long term.

BOB, a communications agency, was selected to develop the brand image and communications strategy for the Let's Start Up Program. Their skilled and inspired creative team developed a logo, stationery and presentation documents for us, which have already created a positive impression among our current and future donors. In addition, these specialists took over the management of our website and social media presence. The agency's entire team proudly invested their heart and soul into the cause and we are extremely grateful to them.















BICOM, a public relations firm, helped promote the Foundation and the Let's Start Up Program in print and digital media, allowing us to gain wider visibility among the general public and donors. The BICOM team drew on their expertise to spread the word about the major shift occurring within our organization in the past year. We would like to thank these talented public relations professionals for their commitment, drive and valuable contribution to our cause.
