OUR MISSION TAKES US HIGHER

Founded in 2009, the Lise Watier Foundation has as its mission to empower socially or economically vulnerable women to tap their talents and follow their dreams so they can build a better future.

We provide local women practical tools and support so they can develop their skills, grow to their full professional potential and achieve sustainable financial autonomy.

Through training, individual counselling and financial assistance, we help them be the very best they can in order to ensure a better future for themselves and their children.

2018-2019 NEW MOMENTUM FOR THE FOUNDATION

The Foundation's development continued on several fronts in 2018–2019, which was positive both for our exposure and for the cause that drives us. Here is a brief overview of the main achievements that have rallied our team over the past 12 months.

LET'S START UP IS SPREADING ITS WINGS

In July 2018, the Let's Start Up Program was implemented at a new service point located in Montérégie. Many women in the region showed interest and the first Montérégian cohort started in September. The Let's Start Up Program is now available in four regions of Quebec:

- Montreal The YWCA
- Laurentians Fonds d'emprunt des Laurentides
- Quebec City Centre étape
- Montérégie Carrefour jeunesse emploi

NEW CONTENT FOR THE PROGRAM

In 2018, we enhanced the Let's Start Up Program with even more innovative content. **Optimum Talent**, an expert human resources consultant, made its SuccessFinder behaviour assessment test available to all participants in the program. This career evaluation tool predicts job satisfaction and success based on the participant's behaviour and skills. The contribution and expertise of business partners helps our program grow and allows participants to thrive even more, providing significant added value!

A STIMULATING MEETING FOR OUR ADVISORS

After a very successful first edition in 2018, a new interregional meeting of Let's Start Up Program advisors was held on January 28 and 29, 2019, in the stimulating setting of Espace CDPQ, in Montreal. The program's advisors were able to attend inspiring conferences given by influential people, including Ghani Kolli, founder and CEO of HumanYo+Impact; Marie-Claude Elie, Senior Account Executive at Google; and Nancy Bélanger, Notary and Tax Advisor. Various roundtable discussions also enabled participants to share ways to improve



services and continue to innovate to make the Let's Start Up Program even more accessible and effective. A big thank-you to all those who contributed to the success of this most beneficial meeting!






AN EXCELLENT YEAR FOR THE LET'S START UP PROGRAM

- This year, 148 women successfully completed the Let's Start Up Program in four regions of Quebec.
- 131 of them have chosen the path of entrepreneurship and have started or completed writing their business plan.
- 16 companies were officially launched by graduates.
- 17 women have taken steps to return to the labour market or continue their studies.
- 6 single mothers received financial assistance to further their post-secondary education.
- 363 hours of training were given.
- 720 hours of personalized support were offered.


